
How to Install Liam WordPress Theme

1) Open WordPress dashboard >> Go to Appearance >> Click on Upload Theme >> **Zip** file that you have Download from Theme Forest




- 2) Now click on Install Now
- 3) Activate It


After installing theme, you will be automatically redirected to the Theme Setup Wizard



3) Here you will see the Setup Wizard First Screen and Click on Get Started




Required Plugins for Liam WordPress Theme




Now click on Install Required Plugins. On this screen all required plugins will install automatically.

After installing plugins click on Proceed with Dummy Content




Now Choose demo which you want to Install




Also, when you mouse hover on the screenshot, you will have two Options

- 2. Select the demo to install on your site




Click on select demo scroll to bottom

Click on import demo button




Now, finally click on Import Data and wait a few minutes for the data import to complete.

Now, you have successfully imported the data, and it will automatically redirect to Theme Options.




Important changes in CubeWP Settings

Please make changes in the current settings, save the settings, and then visit your site. The data has been imported successfully.

Theme Settings

You can change default theme colors from CubeWP >> CubeWP Settings

- 1. **General Tab:** You can change the theme colors that show over the site.
- 2. **Header Tab:** You can change header colors and general settings.
- 3. Footer Tab: You can change footer colors and settings.
- 4. Blog Tab: You can change blog page settings like title, short description, etc.
- 5. **CSS JS Tab:** If you want to add any custom CSS or JS, you can add it in this tab.



Required Plugins/Page Settings

- 1) CubeWP Framework
- 2) CubeWP Forms
- 3) Elementor

Please note: These plugins will install automatically during setup.

Home page, Project page, Contact page

These pages have been built using the Elementor plugin, so you can make changes to anything using Elementor on these pages.

Elements in Elementor

Liam Project: You can use this to showcase your successfully completed projects and design them according to your own color scheme.

CubeWP Posts: You can use this element to display your blogs, with all settings to be configured for display on the site.

Blog page, Blog Detail Page

The blog page has been built using code to display all blogs. However, you can adjust the blog page settings through CubeWP >> CubeWP Settings >> Blogs.

The blog details page is also directly coded to showcase blog posts. The colors for the banner and banner title on this page will automatically update via CubeWP settings >> General.


How to Import Demo Content Manually

To import from a WordPress export file into your website. Follow these steps.

- 1. Log into your site as a WordPress Administrator Panel.
- 2. Now **Go to Tools => Import**
- 3. Click on **WordPress Importer** from the list.
- 4. After click on WordPress you will see a popup of **WordPress Importer**. You need to install **WordPress Importer** for uploading XML file. Now click on "**Install Now**" Button then activate your plugin.

5. Now you can Upload the dummy content .xml file using the form provided on that page then click on "**Upload file and Import**" button.


6. Select your desired content.xml file from that path wp-content\themes\liam-portfolio\include\sdk\import\demo1



7. You will be asked to map the authors in this export file to users on the blog. For each author, you may choose to map to an existing user on the blog or to create a new user. You will then have the choice to import attachments, so click on the "**Download and import file attachments**" check-box and click on "**Submit**" button
